



(Trending) What papers on this topic do SciX users read the most?

How to make your own little book



① Materials we need: ^{scissors (optional)}

② Let's begin!




fold the dashed edges together

③ open back up and



fold the "x" edges together

④ don't open it up this time




fold the long edges together

⑤ now open it back up with the "x" edges still folded together




⑥ Cut through this thick line by: Don't cut through all the way!

⑦ unfold and pinch
